Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of **Amin Tannery Limited** (the company) for the quarter ended March 31, 2021 and the year-to-date results for the period from April 01, 2020to March 31, 2021 (the Statement) attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
